Product overview Crate chair (1934)

In 1934, Rietveld made the first crate furniture from 'crate wood'. Crate wood is a packaging material that he recycled in this manner. In the economic crisis of the 1930's, people wasted nothing! Revolutionary for its time: the crate chair is sold as a kit and is available in various colours.

Rietveld himself said: *"Construction of the crates uses an 'unconstrained carpentry method' that is to the point, strong and inoffensive. The equal width of the wood and the open joints give a restful look."* His ideology that beauty should be accessible to everyone and that simplicity is a characteristic of what is true was given form in the shape of this crate chair.

Crate chair:

In its manufacture, high-quality beech was chosen. This very solidly constructed chair is available in the colours clear varnish, untreated, white, yellow, red, blue and black.

Crate table / stool:

In its manufacture, high-quality beech was chosen. This very solidly constructed table / stool is available in the colours clear varnish, untreated, white, yellow, red, blue and black.

Every piece of furniture is fitted with a chip, a number and an associated certificate.
